Risk Management Framework

Basle Committee on Banking Supervision: Principles for the management of Interest rate risk, September 1997. Generalised principles:

- Clear lines of responsibility: separate risk takers and risk managers X
- Quantitative risk limits and systems for promptly reacting to positions that exceed limits √
- Need to assess all material risks: Focus on both earnings & economic value fluctuations √
- Stress testing to evaluate extreme events and develop contingency plans ✓ ✓
- Regular internal and independent review ?



What they don't teach you!

- Effective communication:
 - Range of stakeholders
- Regulatory challenge:
 - sustainable pace of change?
- Culture CRO now seen as key to this
 - Uniquely positioned to join the dots from Board, through Senior
 Management to Front Line staff



Fundamental challenges

- Understanding the business:
 - Seat at table
- Pro-business:
 - Operating within a 'safe' risk appetite
- Performance:
 - Upside vs downside
