*actuvview is the first streaming platform for actuaries.*

*Developed by the German Association of Actuaries and partners from the actuarial community, actuvview is the first international streaming platform for actuarial media. It is regularly updated with digital content for the actuarial community – either broadcast live from international actuarial events, provided as recorded sessions from actuvview partners or produced as webcasts by individual experts.*

***We are delighted to announce that members of the Society of Actuaries in Ireland now have free access to all content on actuvview. We have secured this benefit as a member association of the Actuarial Association of Europe, which has recently become the key European partner in actuvview. Free access will continue to be available until end 2021.***

## Registering






## Your Online Profile

To access your actuvew profile once logged in, use the small down arrow in the top right hand corner (1) to open up a dropdown of profile options (2)

- In **'My profile'** you can view any of your current details, or in **'Edit profile'** update any personal details.
- In **'My profile'** you can also look at your watch history – *see section on 'Watch Record' for maintenance of CPD verifiable hours.*
- In **'My playlists'** you can again view everything you have viewed or listened to and even create a playlist for future viewing, or reviewing.





## 'My Profile'

This section displays a number of useful tabs:

- **Playlists** – everything you have recently been watching/listening to
- **Documentation** – Your 'Watch Record'
- **Newsletter** – actview news on upcoming events/general info and call for papers
- **Access rights** – Your membership access rights on actview



## 'Watch Record'

This page, accessed through 'My profile' and then by selecting the 'Documentation' tab, will allow you to see your history on the actuview site. This can form verifiable CPD for the purposes of the Society's CPD Scheme.

Your history, or 'Watch Record' can be viewed by year, noting when viewed, the subject matter and the 'Duration viewed'. **90% of any one video must be viewed in one logged-in session to appear in your Watch Record as verifiable CPD.**

## FAQs

- ***Where can I find my one-time use code?***

One-time use codes were sent out by email to all Fellows & Associates of the Society in February 2020. If you cannot locate our communication to you please contact the Society at [info@actuaries.ie](mailto:info@actuaries.ie) and you will be forwarded a reminder of your code.

- ***I am a recently qualified Fellow of the Society, how do I apply for a code?***

Your One Time Code was included in the confirmation letter you received from the Society upon transferring to Fellow. If you do not have this letter, please email [info@actuaries.ie](mailto:info@actuaries.ie).

- ***I am a student, can I watch content on actuvie?***

Yes, if you contact the Society at [info@actuaries.ie](mailto:info@actuaries.ie) and your Student Membership is confirmed you will be issued your one-time use code.

- ***How is my CPD verified?***

We require 90% of each video to be watched to be able to claim it as verifiable CPD. Your Watch Record will retain an account of this watch history and you can use this as evidence for your CPD Returns.

- ***I've registered with my one-time use code and set up my own profile, but I don't appear to be fully registered. Do I require a new code?***

There can be a small delay in the platform fully registering your personal profile due to large uptake. Please wait a few minutes and log back in with your recently set up login and password.
