

## 100 Point Identifier Check

The National Vetting (Children and Vulnerable Persons) Act 2012 makes it a legal requirement to vet those involved in work or activity, where they will have regular access to or contact with children or vulnerable adults.

This information sheet has been developed to support organisations in verifying the identity of vetting subjects (those applying to be Garda Vetted) as required by the Act. When conducting Garda Vetting, organisations should require volunteers or workers to present identification totaling 100 points to ensure they are checking the correct person. At least one form of photographic evidence must be gathered.
