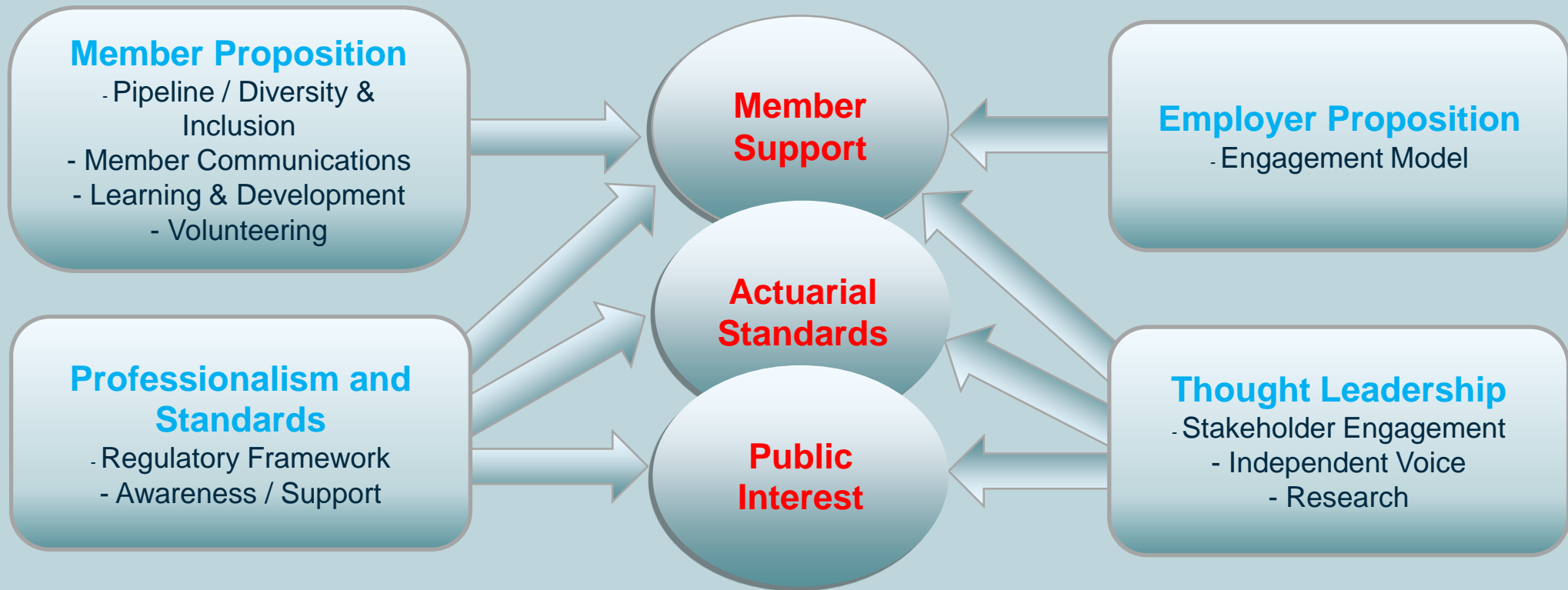

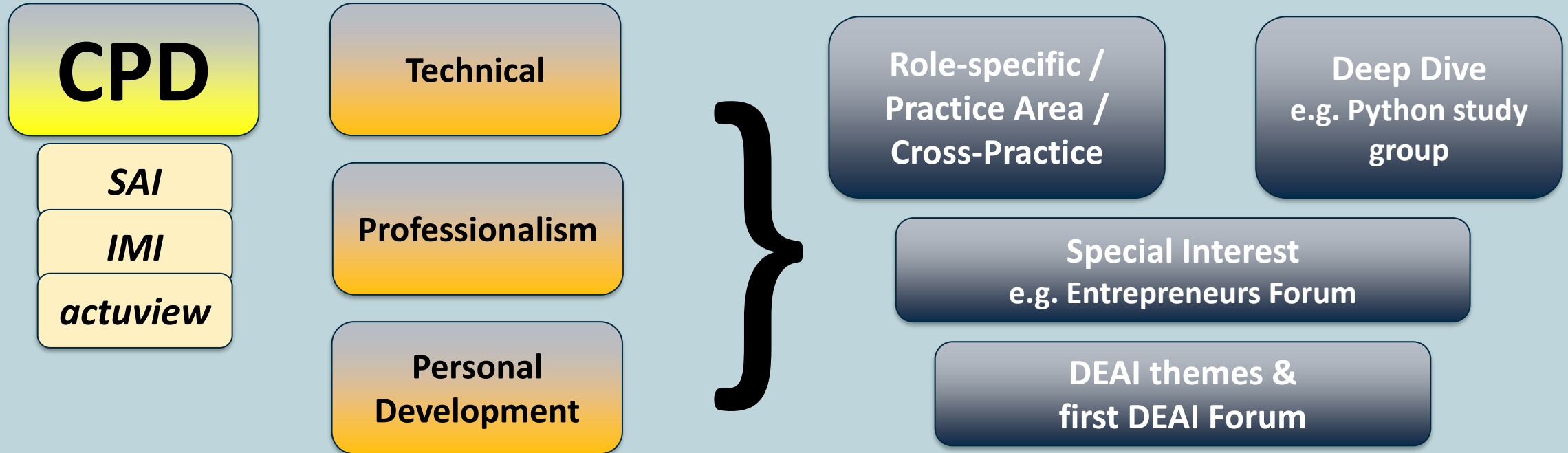

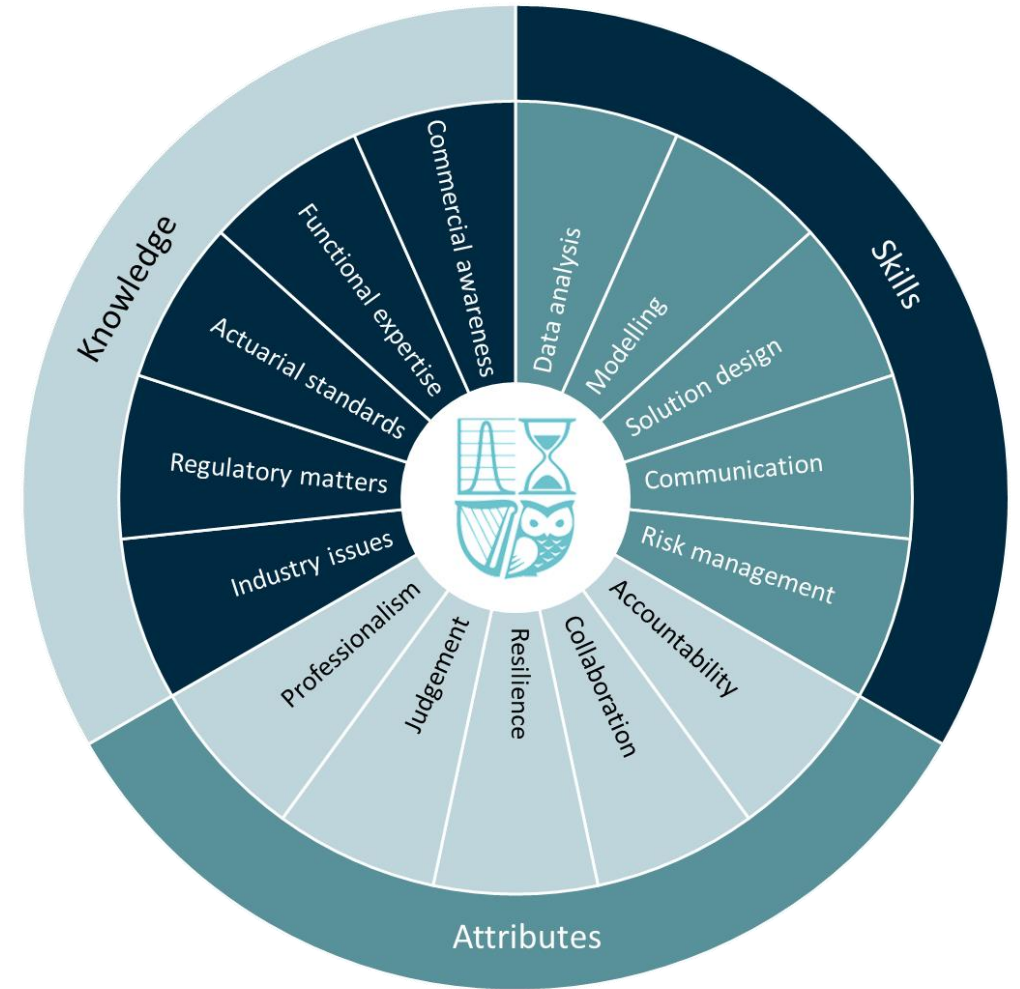

Competency Framework

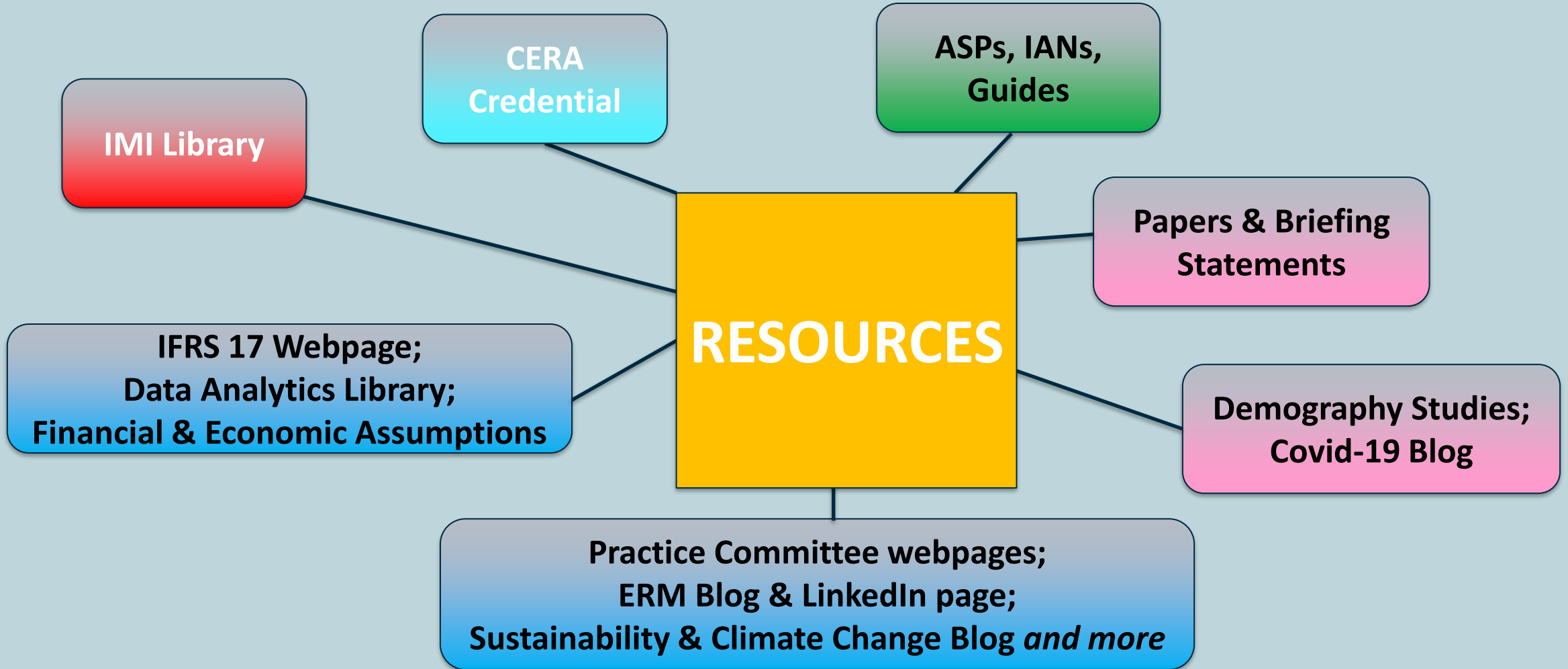
Our **Competency Framework** illustrates the range of technical and non-technical skills / competencies that actuaries typically draw on, depending on their role

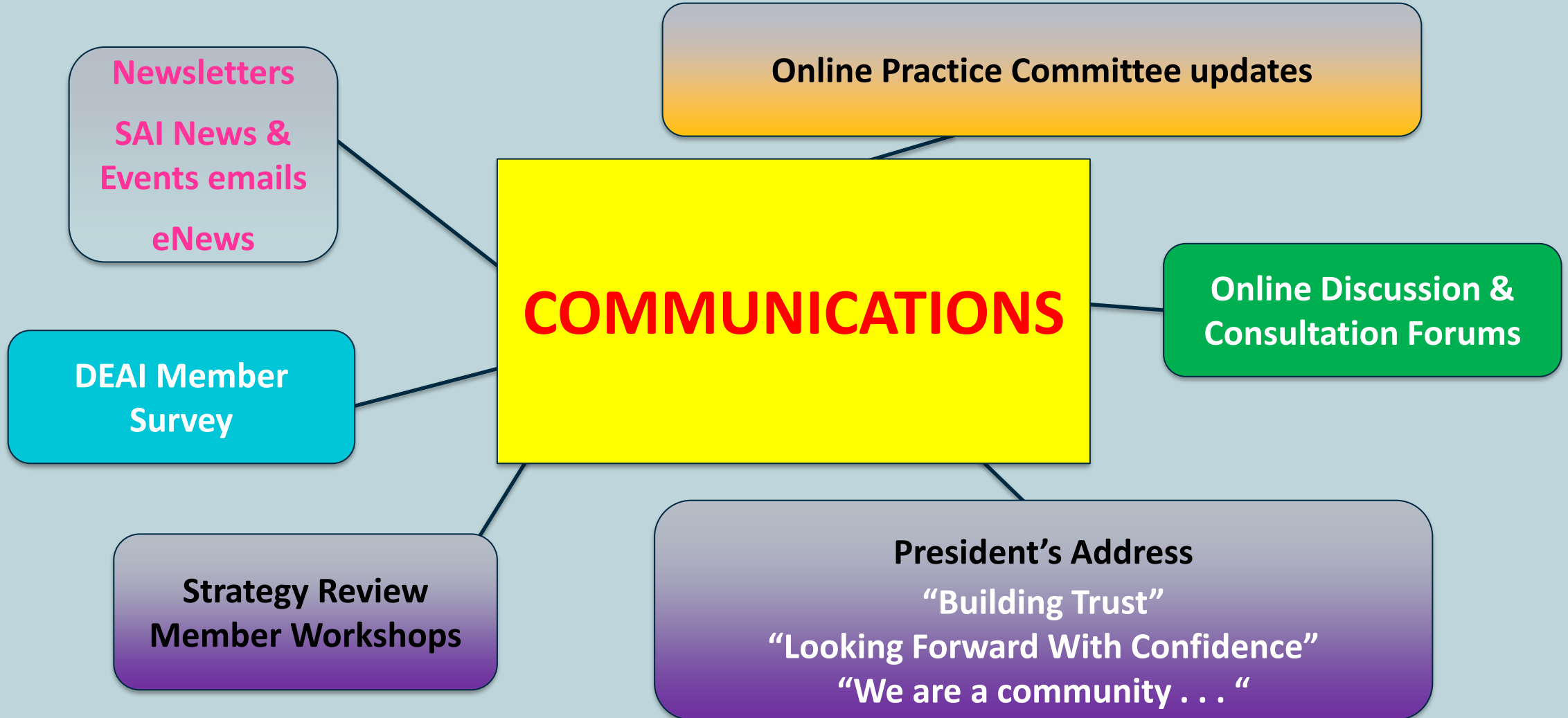

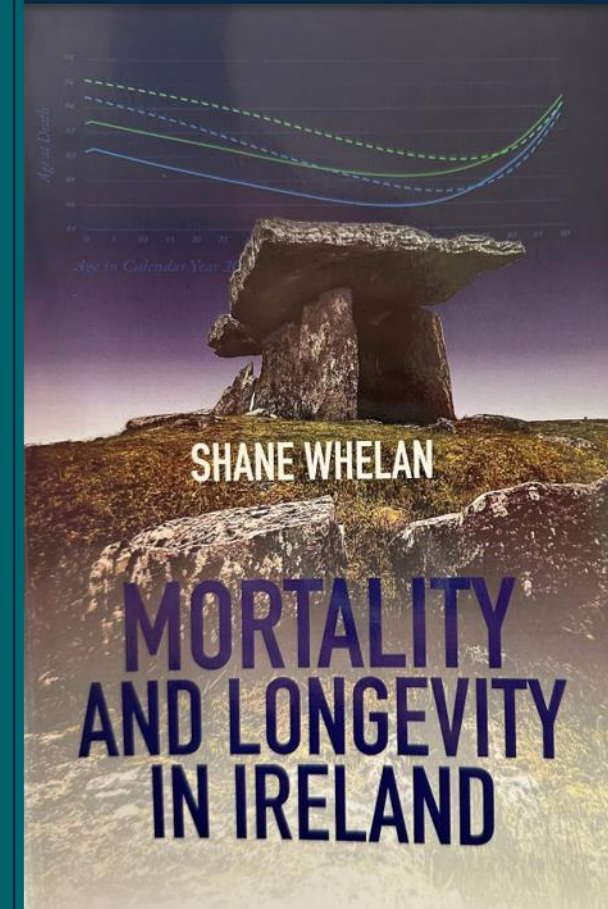

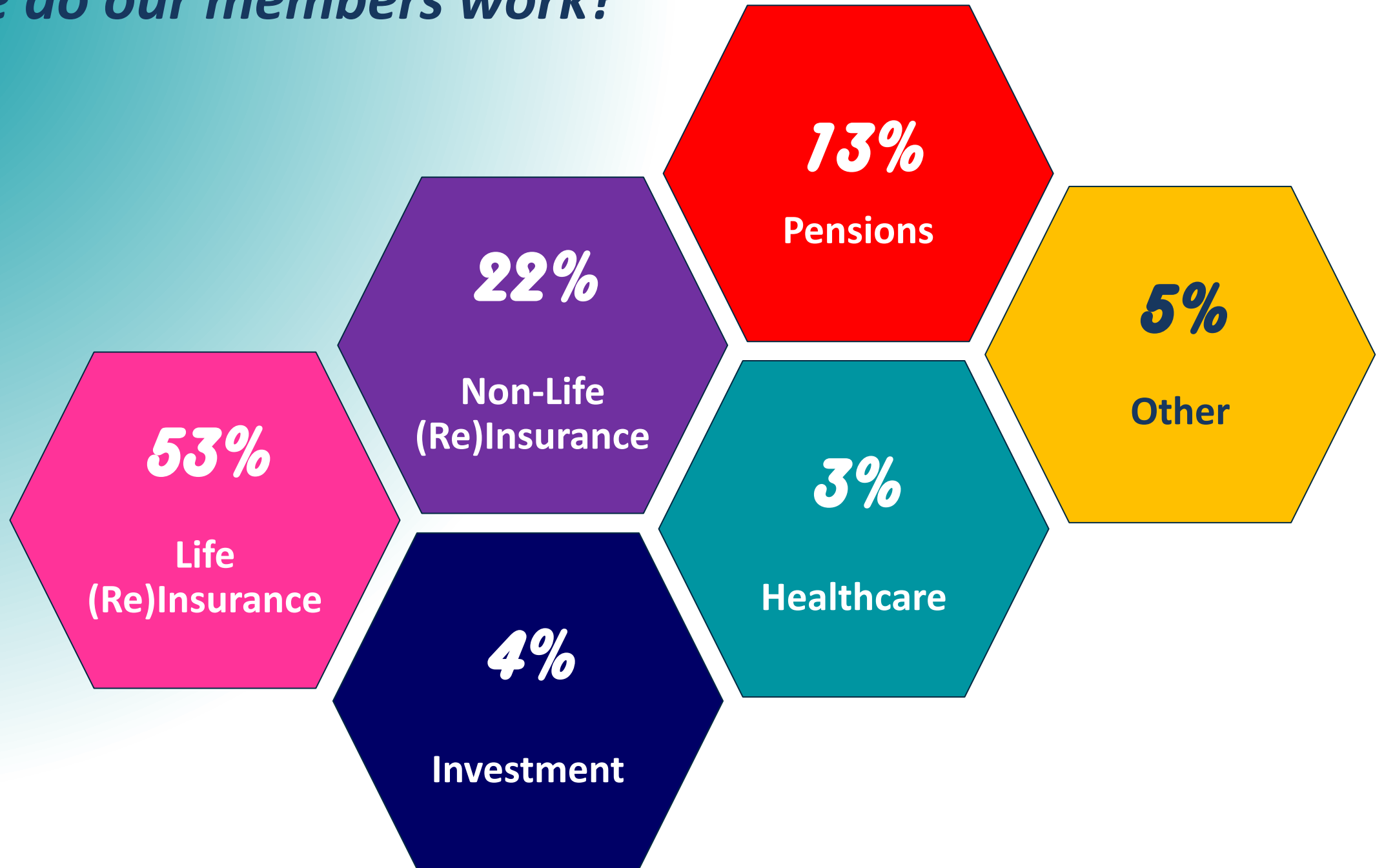
