Technology and Equipment

- What will be provided in the exam hall? (e.g. laptop, PC, monitor, keyboard, mouse)
- · Can students use their own keyboard and mouse for the exam?
- What will the operating system be on the laptop/PC provided? (e.g. Windows, MacOS, Linux)
- Will students have access to Excel during a Paper A exam format, which is typically done in Word?

Exam Setup and Materials

- Will a printed copy of the exam paper be provided to students in the exam centre?
- Will the IFoA provide the Actuarial Tables, or must students bring their own?
- Will scrap paper be provided? If not, can students bring their own?
- Will an A4 whiteboard be provided in the exam centre?
- For CP3, what materials can students bring to the exam? Will the IFoA provide a copy of the pre-reading material?

Exam Conditions and Timing

- Will time reminders be given throughout the exam (e.g, warnings of 1 hour left)?
- Were the exam papers written with the assumption that exams would be closedbook?
- If a student arrives up to 15 minutes late for reasons outside their control, will they still be allowed to enter the exam? Is there a grace period for late arrivals?

Accommodation and Personal Items

- Do items on the "comfort aid" list (e.g., hearing aids) require additional approval to be used?
- What personal items are students permitted to take to the exam with them? (e.g. watch)
