




#### **Schemes by Pensioner Numbers**


























#### Schemes by Funding Level of Pensioners – end 2008



The number of pensioners with coverage less than 100% was 15,000. Four large schemes accounted for 10,000 of these pensioners.




#### Schemes by Funding Level of Actives and Deferreds – end 2008
