Champagne Scramble Instructions

- 1. Full handicaps apply
- 2. All players tee-off
- 3. The team will choose the best drive from which all players play their second shot. The player whose drive is chosen must play the ball as it lies before the other team members play their shots from the placed position.

Note 4 drives from every player must be taken – please write the initials of the player whose drive was chosen on the score card.

Balls to be <u>placed</u> within two-feet (6 inches if on the green), no nearer the hole, of the ball chosen and marked. If in the rough or a bunker the ball can be placed but should stay in the rough or bunker.

- 4. From this point each player will play their own ball and record their stableford points score for the hole.
- 5. The best two scores from the team on each hole to count towards the overall score.
- 6. As you can see from above the format is almost identical to a fourball format apart from the use of the best drive for the second shot.
- 7. SLOW PLAY Scramble can be quite slow so I would encourage you to try to keep up with the group in front and don't spend long looking for balls

Dinner and prizes

There is no formal sit-down meal included. I thought it would be easier for people to order and pay for their food from the bar menu as they finish to save too much hanging around for the early starters. The prize giving will be held as soon as all groups are in.
